Who Should Participate? Individuals working in any type of food service business including restaurants, day-care centers, nursing homes, schools, etc.

Back by popular demand, this two-day training session prepares participants to take the official ServSafe® certification exam which is offered at the conclusion of the training. Gloucester County College is proud to offer six sessions of this program in 2010 – choose the session that best suits your schedule.

ServSafe® meets the needs of changing New Jersey food laws and regulations and recognizes program completers as certified Food Safety Managers. The ServSafe® Program was developed by restaurant and food service experts for food safety professionals. It sets the standard with comprehensive food safety training and an accredited certification examination. The exam is provided at the end of the second session. The participant's cost of \$120 includes two days of training, the ServSafe® book and exam. Instruction is provided in English, but we can provide the book and exam in Chinese or Spanish, if needed.

Cost: \$120 (Includes two days of training, ServSafe® book, exam, and all materials)

The usual cost for this training is \$200 but thanks to funding provided by the United States Department of Labor, Job Training Partnership, we are able to off-set one-third the cost! The cost of \$120 reflects that discount for the classes below in 2010! Don't delay; register today!

- The cost does not include retesting for those participants who must re-take the exam. One exam is included with the cost of training. For retesting at a future date, a \$55 fee will be required.
- Class and testing fees are non-refundable.
- For cancellations received at least one week prior to the training, the \$120 fee will be applied to a future ServSafe© offering at Gloucester County College.
- If Gloucester County College is forced to cancel a class, the participant will be placed in a future class at no additional cost.

FROM 295 NORTHBOUND: Take Exit 18 (Mt. Royal). At the top of the ramp turn right at the light onto Berkley Road. (Follow signs to Mt. Royal) At second traffic light, turn wide right (go between firehouse and convenience store) onto County House Road. Fire Academy is on the left side about 1 mile from the Berkley Road intersection.

FROM 295 SOUTHBOUND: Take Exit 18 (Clarksboro-Paulsboro). At the top of the ramp turn left at the light onto Berkley Road. (Follow signs to Mt. Royal) Go the 3rd light and turn wide right (go between firehouse and convenience store) onto County House Road. Fire Academy is on left side about 1 mile from the Berkley Road intersection.

FROM ATLANTIC CITY: Take Route 322 West to Route 45 North and turn right. Continue on Route 45 to Cohawkin Road and turn left. Take Cohawkin Road to County House Road and turn right (across from cemetery). Fire Academy is on the right about 1 mile from the Cohawkin Road intersection.

FROM NORTH JERSEY (NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE): Take New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 4 (Rout3 73 North). Travel for approximately ½ mile and enter onto I-295 South. Follow Directions for "From 295 Southbound" found above.

FROM VINELAND: Take Route 55 North to Route 322 West exit. Continue on Route 322 West through two traffic lights. After the second traffic light (Wawa Store), there is a right hand fork. This is Cedar Road (Co. Highway 667) - there will be a sign for Jefferson and Clearview High School at this intersection. Turn right at Cedar Road (Co. Highway 667). Follow Cedar Road past Clearview High School and past one traffic light (Route 45). Cross over Route 45 and continue on Cedar Road. (stay to your right-Cedar Road becomes Cohawkin Road). Approximately 2-3 miles down Cohawkin Road you will make a right turn onto County House Road. (across from cemetery) Fire Academy is on the right about 1 mile.
